## The Seminar

The oil palm (*Elaeis guineensis*) is an important tree crop in the tropics. In South East Asia, oil palm has been cultivated more than 100 years. Like all crops, it is susceptible to pests and diseases, which can cause very serious losses in production. *Oryctes rhinoceros*, bagworm, *Tirathaba* sp., and *Ganoderma* are posing a serious threat to the oil palm if left unmanaged. The problems become complicated with some current issues like resistency of some weeds and less aggressive of *Elaeidobius kamerunicus* as main pollinator in oil palm plantation.

The 6<sup>th</sup> IOPRI-MPOB International Seminar will present the latest findings on identification and management of pests and diseases on oil palm for high productivity. The seminar will be held in conjunction with 100<sup>th</sup> years IOPRI anniversary in September 2016.

## Objectives

1. To inform on the recent updates of major pests, *Ganoderma* disease, weeds and oil palm insect pollinator.
2. To create awareness among oil palm stakeholders of the current approaches of research and management of pests and *Ganoderma* disease in oil palm for high productivity.

The programme will include oral and poster paper presentations and followed by company exhibition. Oral and poster papers are in English.
